Students who are absent from exams

Any student absent from an exam should be reported to the exams team within ten minutes of the exam starting time. The best method of communicating absences is via Teams.

The invigilation team will record absences on the absence list provided in the exam packs.

The exams team will make efforts to try and locate the missing students:

Check to see if student has not withdrawn Attempt to contact student using Mobile number and texting them.

If successful in contacting, try to get student to exam hall (following the Policy for late students)

If unsuccessful record details of absence in log and amend attendance registers accordingly.

Candidates who are absent should at the earliest opportunity be recorded on Journal ensuring relevant Pastoral lead is notified.
